

CONFORMATION CLASSES AND BREEDS FOR THE US BULLY REGISTRY

USBR recognizes and registration for the following Breeds:

- American Bully with varieties: Standard, Pocket, XL and Extreme
- American Bulldog
- American Pit Bull Terrier
- Bull Terrier
- English Bulldog
- Exotic Bully
- French Bulldog
- Shorty Bull
- Olde English Bulldog

Each Breed has the following class break downs:

- Pre-Novice 3-6 months (no points)
- Puppy 6-12 months
- Junior 1-2 years
- Adult 2-3 years
- Senior 3 & up
- Bred By (owner must be breeder or family member)

Conformation points will be awarded based on the following:

1st Place	1st Place in class 10 Points	Best Male/Female Breeds with no varieties 20 points Breeds with Varieties (Am Bully-standard, pocket XL and Extreme) 20 points	Best of Winners Breed with no variety 20 points Breeds with Variety 10 points	Best in Show/Breed (only points earned are for top 20 dogs) 1 point

REGULAR DOG CLASSES

- All dogs will get 10 points for 1st place in the class even if there is no competition
- 1st Place winners from each class will compete for Best Male and Female
- Dogs can only compete in one class/variety per show
- Reserve Best Male and Female will be given out in case the winner is found not to be eligible for win.
- The Best Male and Female/and Best of the Varieties will compete for Best of Winners.
- In order to receive the points for Best Male or Female or Best of Winners there must be competition. (at least 1 other dog in competition class or group)

CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS

To earn a Champion title the dog must complete the following:

Points for earning Championship

- A total of 150 points is required for an USBR Show Championship title.
- Dog must earn at least three wins (majors) as Best Male/Female.
- Example: Your dog is a pocket and you had you had at least one other dog in your variety. You beat the other dog-you get best pocket male. You then compete and win Best of Pocket over a female. You would get a total of 50 points (10-20-20)
- Dog must receive majors under three different judges.
- You are able to move your dog up (for the next show) if you have checked your points with the office-show host or USBR are not responsible if your dog has not completed the amount of points needed to become a Champion.

CHAMPION CLASS

- Your dog should be confirmed by the USBR office before entering the class.
- You are responsible if your dog has not meant the requirements.
- Champion class must have 3 dogs competing in order for wins to count.
- Reserve Champion will be rewarded in case winner is found to be eligible for win.

GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS

To earn a grand Champion title the dog must complete the following:

Points for earning Grand Championship

- Dogs must receive 4 Champion wins with at least 2 other dogs competing.
- Dog must receive 3 of Champion wins under 3 different judges.
- Example: Your dog has shown to Judge A, B, and C and received best Champion with 2 other dogs competing. You can show again to either Judge A, B or C and the win will count towards your title.

GRAND CHAMPION CLASS

- Your dog should be confirmed by the USBR office before entering the class.
- You are responsible if your dog has not meant the requirements
- Only one Grand Champion will be selected as the winner.

BEST OF BREED(BOB) and BEST IN SHOW (BIS)

BOB will consist of the following

- Best of Winners
- Champion Class Winner
- Grand Champion winner
- BOB winner will receive 1 point for every BOB win for USBR Top 20 for each year.
- USBR show results will be posted on the website each month

BIS will consist of the following

- The BOB winners from each breed enter at the USBR show.
- BIS winner will receive 1 point for their breed Top 20.
